

## Corrugated Rib Boot Cuffs

Dress up your boots and get the look of knee socks without all the fuss

### Materials:

1 Skein Crystal Palace Sausalito  
(198 yds)

80% Super-wash Merino 20% Nylon

Size 3 16" circular needle

Stitch Marker & Tapestry Needle

### Gauge:

7 sts = 1" in corrugated rib

### Finished Size:

13.5" around & 2 3/4" wide

### Corrugated Rib

Round 1 and all following rounds: Knit 2 with main strand used for your first 5 purl rounds, Purl 2 with yarn strand from the opposite end of your skein. Strand the unused yarn along the back of your work being sure not to pull too tightly as you switch between strands.

### 2x2 Rib

Round 1 and all following rounds: Knit 2 Purl 2.

Cast on 88 stitches. Purl 1 row. Place marker and join to work in the round, making sure stitches are not twisted.

Purl 4 rounds.

Switch to Corrugated Rib and continue in rounds until piece measures approximately 2 3/4" from cast on edge.

Drop second strand and continue with strand used for the cast on.

Purl 5 rounds.

Begin 2x2 rib and continue until 2x2 Rib measures approximately 2 3/4".

Bind off loosely in 2x2 rib pattern.

Make another one to match.

Pull on your boots and go splash in some puddles!
