Fixation Headband in Three Styles LYS Tour Pattern 2007

One ball of Cascade Fixation, size 6 needles

Gauge = 7 stitches per inch in garter stitch.

Cast on 8 stitches using your favorite method or a provisional method.

Knit 20 rows.

Increase:

K1, kfb, knit to last two stitches, kfb, K 1

Knit next two rows.

K1, kfb, knit to last two stitches, kfb, K1

Knit next two rows.

K1, kfb, knit to last two stitches, kfb, K1(14 sts)

Work one of the following stitch patterns for 62 rows or
approx. 7 1/2" from beginning of pattern.

Pattern A: Garter Stitch [knit every row]

Pattern B: Seed Stitch:

Row 1:K1, P1 to end of row

Row 2:P1, K1 to end of row 2

Repeat these two rows.

Pattern C: Granite Relief Stitch:

Row 1: knit

Row 2: K2tog across row

Row 3: knit into the front and back of each st. across row

Row 4: purl row

Repeat these four rows.

Decrease:

K1, k2tog, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Knit next two rows.

K1, k2tog, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Knit next two rows.

K1, K2tog, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Knit 20 rows.

Bind off and sew seam or undo provisional cast on and use three needle bind off.
